High-Lights of Jame-Ul-Uloom

This prestigious School of ours is a linguistic minority institution. This is a recognised institution which was started in the year 1983-84, with just two pupils in the basement of the Masjid. By the grace of Allah, and with the full co-operation of the office bearers and Trustees, the institutions have expanded by leaps and bounds. At present we have around 3,500 pupils, studying in different courses.

This institution of Jame-ul-uloom which is attached to Jamia Masjid, imparts Deeniyath and moral education to all its pupils apart from the formal education. This is to mould the character of the young and to develop in them a desire to live an honourable life in the modern society.

For Primary Classes

1. Promotion from class I and IV Std. shall be decided on the basis of continuous comprehensive assesment made every month of the work done in the class and assignments given to the children, in Semester Examination.

2. Home work is given to encourage and develop independent study skill

3. Home work time table is given to all students who are required to complete the work as assigned by subject teachers.

4. Class assesments are considered to evaluate their over all performance through out the year. Remedial classes for slow learners are conducted on a regular basis to help and boost their academic performance.

Jame-ul-uloom High School

Started in 1990-91 this school has so far sent 20 batches of students for S.S.L.C Examination of them 11 batches gave us 100% results. During the year 2012-2013, 158 Students appeared for the SSLC Examination. Out of 158 students 24 students obtained distinctions and the percentage pass was 100 %

Extra Curricular Activities

All round development of the personality of a child is the goal of education and besides academics students are given opportunities in extra curricular activities like Quiz, debate, fancydress, painting, creative writing etc. to develop their own talents. Students attend competitions organised by other schools and DHIE.

Teachers day and childrens day, national festivals like Independence day and Republic day are some of the occasions when the children exhibit their talents in various fields.

Compulsory Computer Education

It is an accepted fact that in the modern age, life will be blank without computers. With a view to keep our students abreast with the modern information, computer education is made compulsory right from IV Standard. Arrangement for computer education is made separately for girls and boys in different blocks.

Examination & Promotion

A time table is given a week before a test/Examination. Pupils absent for any reason are not re-examined. In case of an unforeseen holiday, the test/examination of the day will be conducted after the last paper as per the time table.

The final Examination report for all students from 1 Std to 1X Std will be issued in April 2014 to confirm the result of the years work.

75 % attendance is mandatory for all the students.

Promotion is decided by the head mistress in consultation with teachers. Answer papers of final Examination shall not be given to parents/guardians. Answer papers of other tests/examination will be shown to parents/guardians.

School Discipline

- 1. Our School is known for its values. A man may achieve any height he aspires, but if he is ignorant of the basic values like discipline, punctuality, good mannerism, respect, love, compassion etc., he has not gained much in life.*
- 2. The School follows certain norms to help the students achieve these goals. All students are expected to be well aware of all the rules and also to follow them without any lapse.*
- 3. As the medium of instruction is English, children should speak in English in the school premises with their teachers and companions to develop their conversation ability. Parents should encourage their children to talk in English, in addition with their mother-tongue at home with brothers and sisters.*
- 4. Students should bring the school diary everyday to school. They should bring to the class the necessary text books and note books as per the time table.*
- 5. It is necessary that the students cultivate the best etiquette and conduct themselves well in school and wherever they go. It is important that the students bear in mind the fact that the school is judged by their conduct, behaviour and performance. They should always greet their teachers, elders and friends in an amiable and audible tone of voice whenever and wherever they meet them in school or outside.*

6. ***Cellphones are strictly prohibited.***

7. *A school canteen is provided in the premises. Students are prohibited to buy eatables from outside the school campus. No student will be sent home in between school hours. In case of emergency the parents should contact the Headmistress.*

8. *The school authorities reserve the right to dismiss those students whose progress in studies is unsatisfactory.*

9. *Students are responsible for all personal belongings.*

10. *Students are expected to be with in the school campus by 8.40 a.m. Repeated late-coming and disinterest in studies will not be tolerated. Discipline in the assembly, in the classrooms and in between the periods should be maintained.*

11. *Leave of absence will not be granted without prior submission of leave application from the parent or guardian. In case of absence without a leave letter, on returning to school the students must bring the leave note signed by the parent or guardian*

12. *Neatness and cleanliness are insisted, students are expected to come to school daily in freshly laundered uniform with clean socks and well polished shoes. Any student who comes to school in a slovenly condition*

will be excluded from class or sent home

13. *Attendance is mandatory on the first and last day of each term*

Results :

Pupils are taken to visit places of historical or geographical interest. All students are expected to participate in these excursions, whenever such excursions are arranged separately for both boys and girls.

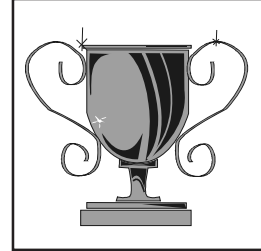
While on the Bus / Van.
